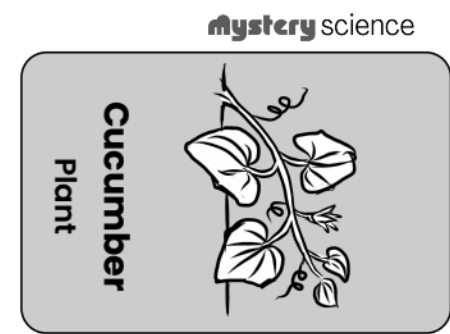
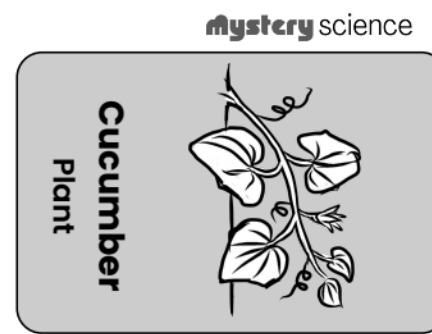
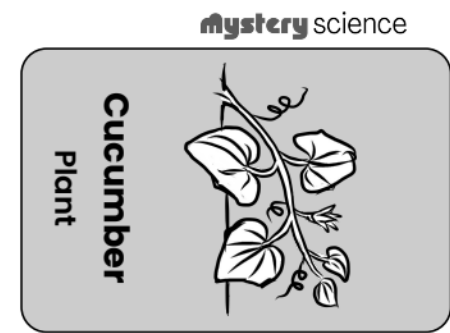
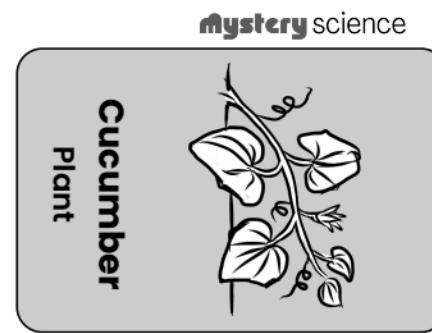
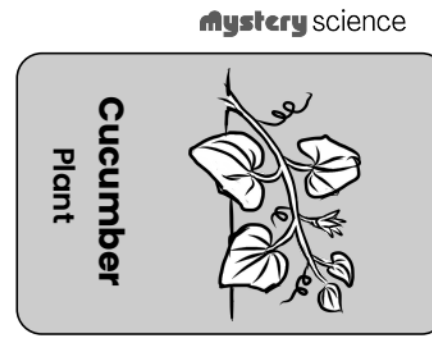
Why are there so many different kinds of flowers?




