

## Lesson: Why does the Moon change shape?

---

<b>crescent moon</b>	moon phase when the Moon looks like a sliver
<b>cycle</b>	a set of events that repeats in the same order over and over
<b>full moon</b>	moon phase when the Moon looks like a circle
<b>gibbous moon</b>	moon phase when the Moon looks like a little less than a full circle
<b>half moon</b>	moon phase when the Moon looks like half of a circle
<b>model</b>	a pretend version of something that scientists use when the real thing is too big, small, or complicated to work with
<b>Moon</b>	a large, round object in the night sky that can reflect the Sun's light
<b>moon phase</b>	the part of the Moon that we can see on a particular night
<b>new moon</b>	moon phase when the Moon looks completely dark
<b>orbit (revolve)</b>	circling another object, like the Moon around the Earth
<b>pattern</b>	something that happens again and again and again in a way that can be predicted
