

## Lesson: Why do some sea creatures look so strange?

---

<b>adaptation</b>	a physical trait or behavior that helps a living thing survive in its environment
<b>camouflage</b>	to blend in with the place around you
<b>behavior</b>	the actions and reactions of living things
<b>environment</b>	all the living and nonliving things in a particular place
<b>evidence</b>	information that can be used to support or reject an idea
<b>external</b>	the outside of something, including the outside of living things
<b>function</b>	what something does
<b>internal</b>	the inside of something, including the inside of living things
<b>predator</b>	an animal that hunts and eats other animals
<b>prey</b>	an animal that is hunted by and eaten by another animal
<b>species</b>	one specific kind of living thing that has similar characteristics and can produce offspring with one another
<b>structure</b>	the specific form and shape of something
<b>system</b>	a group of things that affect each other and function as a whole
<b>trait</b>	something you can observe about a living thing, such as the broad fins of a fish
