| <b>animal</b>    | a living thing that needs to eat other living things                            |
| <b>beak</b>      | the part of a bird that it uses to eat  |
| <b>behavior</b>  | what an animal does   |
| <b>different</b> | not the same  |
| <b>food</b>      | something that animals eat  |
| <b>footprint</b> | a mark left behind when a foot presses into soft ground                         |
| <b>forest</b>    | a place with lots of trees  |
| <b>needs</b>     | things an animal or plant must have in order to live                            |
| <b>pattern</b>   | something that happens again and again and again in a way that can be predicted |
| <b>similar</b>   | somewhat the same   |
| <b>survive</b>   | to stay alive   |
| <b>wing</b>      | a body part used for flying   |
