| <b>attract</b>    | to pull toward                                                             |
| <b>experiment</b> | a test used to discover new information about a question                   |
| <b>force</b>      | a push or a pull                                                           |
| <b>magnet</b>     | an object that can attract or repel certain materials, often metals        |
| <b>magnetic</b>   | something that can be pushed and pulled by magnets                         |
| <b>magnetize</b>  | to make a material magnetic                                                |
| <b>material</b>   | what something is made of, like metal, wood, or plastic                    |
| <b>metal</b>      | a natural material that is often shiny and you cannot see through it       |
| <b>property</b>   | something you can observe about an object or material                      |
| <b>repel</b>      | to push away, such as when two magnets with the same poles face each other |
