| branch | a part of a tree that grows out from the trunk and usually has leaves |
| design | to make a plan for creating or doing something |
| engineer | a person who uses science to come up with solutions to problems |
| invent | to create something new, often an object or a way of doing something |
| leaf | a part of a plant that is often flat and green |
| root | a part of a plant that is usually under the ground |
| shade | a dark, cool place that is not directly in the sunlight |
| structure | the specific form and shape of something |
| tree | a type of plant that has a trunk and branches |
| trunk | the thick middle part of a tree |
| umbrella | a cover that protects from rain or sunlight |
| wind | moving air |
