

## Lesson: Why do the stars come out at night?

---

<b>astronomy</b>	the study of outer space
<b>constellation</b>	a group of stars that form a pattern
<b>day</b>	the time when the Sun is in the sky
<b>model</b>	a pretend version of something that scientists use when the real thing is too big, small, or complicated to work with`
<b>Moon</b>	a large, round object that you can usually see in the night sky
<b>night</b>	the time when the Sun is not in the sky
<b>observe</b>	to pay close attention to something
<b>star</b>	a bright light that can be seen in the night sky
<b>sunrise</b>	when the Sun appears in the morning
<b>sunset</b>	when the Sun disappears in the evening
<b>telescope</b>	a tool used to make very distant objects look closer, often used to look at outer space
