| animal dispersal | when an animal moves a seed from one place to another |
| compare | to notice what is similar and what is different between things |
| disperse | to move and spread out |
| model | a pretend version of something that scientists use when the real thing is too big, small, or complicated to work with |
| observe | to pay close attention to something |
| seed | a part of a plant that can grow into a baby plant |
| seedling | a young plant that grows from a seed |
| structure | the specific form and shape of something |
| water dispersal | when water moves a seed from one place to another |
| wind dispersal | when the wind moves a seed from one place to another |
