gas	matter that spreads out to completely fill a space
investigate	to figure out the answer to a question or to understand how something works
liquid	matter that takes the shape of its container
matter	anything that takes up space and has weight; can be in different forms such as solid, liquid, or gas
model	a pretend version of something that scientists use when the real thing is too big, small, or complicated to work with
particle	a very tiny thing, too small to be seen
solid	matter that is rigid and holds its shape
states of matter	the different forms of matter that include solid, liquid, and gas
