<b>animal</b>	a living thing that needs to eat other living things
<b>beak</b>	the part of a bird that it uses to eat
<b>behavior</b>	what an animal does
<b>different</b>	not the same
<b>food</b>	something that animals eat
<b>footprint</b>	a mark left behind when a foot presses into soft ground
<b>forest</b>	a place with lots of trees
<b>needs</b>	things an animal or plant must have in order to live
<b>pattern</b>	something that happens again and again and again in a way that can be predicted
<b>similar</b>	somewhat the same
<b>survive</b>	to stay alive
<b>wing</b>	a body part used for flying
