flower	a part of a plant that is usually brightly colored
function	what something does
model	a pretend version of something that scientists use when the real thing is too big, small, or complicated to work with
nectar	a sugary liquid that plants make
pollen	a part of a flower that is powdery and helps the plant make seeds
pollination	the process of moving pollen from one flower to the stigma of another flower
pollinator	a living thing that moves pollen from one flower to the stigma of another flower
seed	a part of a plant that can grow into a baby plant
stigma	a part of a flower that is sticky and helps the plant make seeds
structure	the specific form and shape of something
