

## Lesson: Can selection happen without people?

---

<b>adaptation</b>	a trait that helps a living thing survive
<b>generation</b>	all the living things born and living at around the same time
<b>graph</b>	an image that helps you understand information
<b>inherited trait</b>	a trait of a living thing that comes from its parents
<b>natural selection</b>	a process where certain traits help a living thing survive, so those traits are more likely to be passed to the next generation of offspring
<b>population</b>	how many there are of a particular type of living thing
<b>predator</b>	an animal that hunts and eats other animals
<b>species</b>	one specific kind of living thing that has similar characteristics and can produce offspring with one another
<b>survive</b>	to stay alive
<b>trait</b>	something you can observe about a living thing, such as the number of toe scales of a lizard
<b>variation</b>	the different versions of a trait, such as the number of toe scales of a lizard
