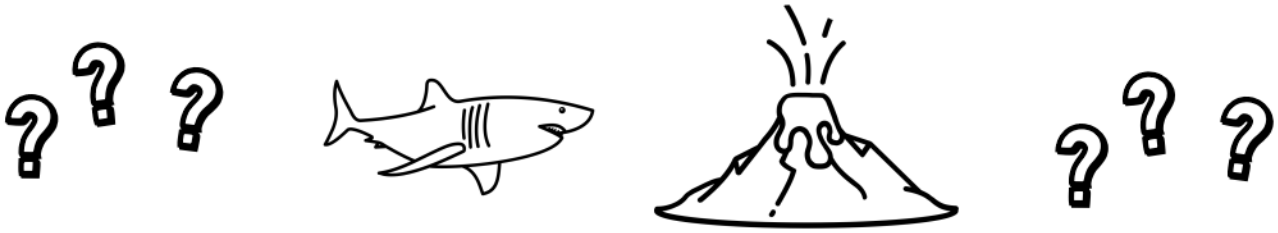


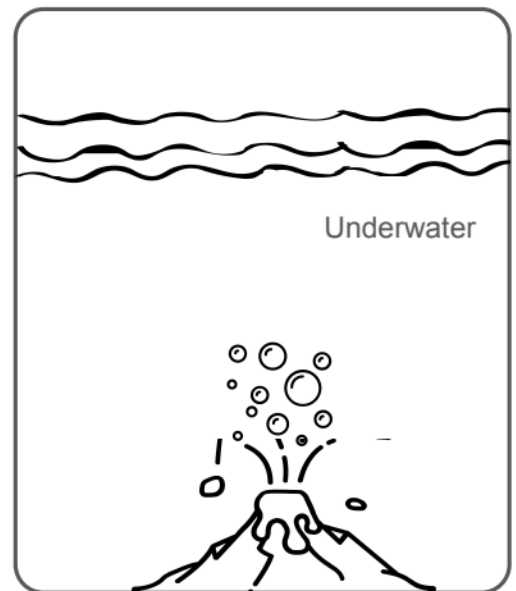
Can a shark live near a volcano?
