

## Lesson: How many different kinds of weather are there?

---

<b>cloud</b>	a puffy, white object floating in the sky
<b>cloudy</b>	when there are lots of clouds, not sunny
<b>cold</b>	not hot or warm
<b>dry</b>	not wet
<b>hot</b>	very warm
<b>observe</b>	to pay close attention to something
<b>rain</b>	water drops that fall from clouds
<b>rainy</b>	when there is lots of rain
<b>snow</b>	solid water that falls from the sky when it's very cold outside
<b>snowy</b>	when there is lots of snow
<b>Sun</b>	the large ball of light in the sky during the day
<b>sunny</b>	when there is lots of light from the Sun, not cloudy
<b>temperature</b>	how hot or cold something is
<b>warm</b>	slightly cooler than hot
<b>weather</b>	what the air is like at a particular time and place
<b>wind</b>	moving air
<b>windy</b>	when there is lots of wind
