

## Lesson: How do we know what dinosaurs looked like?

<b>bones</b>	the hard parts inside many animals that help give their bodies shape
<b>carnivore</b>	an animal that eats only other animals
<b>claim</b>	to say or write an idea
<b>dinosaur</b>	a type of animal that lived long ago and that shares traits with modern birds and reptiles
<b>evidence</b>	information that can be used to support or reject an idea
<b>extinct</b>	when a type of living thing no longer exists
<b>fossil</b>	the remains of a plant or animal that lived a very, very long time ago
<b>herbivore</b>	an animal that only eats plants
<b>observe</b>	to pay close attention to something
<b>paleontologist</b>	a scientist who studies fossils
<b>skeleton</b>	all of the bones of an animal
