<b>animal dispersal</b>	when an animal moves a seed from one place to another
<b>compare</b>	to notice what is similar and what is different between things
<b>disperse</b>	to move and spread out
<b>model</b>	a pretend version of something that scientists use when the real thing is too big, small, or complicated to work with
<b>observe</b>	to pay close attention to something
<b>seed</b>	a part of a plant that can grow into a baby plant
<b>seedling</b>	a young plant that grows from a seed
<b>structure</b>	the specific form and shape of something
<b>water dispersal</b>	when water moves a seed from one place to another
<b>wind dispersal</b>	when the wind moves a seed from one place to another
