

## Lesson: How many different kinds of animals are there?

---

<b>animal</b>	a living thing that needs to eat other living things
<b>bird</b>	a type of animal that lays eggs, has feathers, and has bones
<b>birth</b>	when animals have babies
<b>bones</b>	the hard parts inside many animals that help give their bodies shape
<b>characteristic</b>	something you can observe about an object, place, or living thing
<b>hatch</b>	to come out of an egg
<b>invertebrate</b>	a type of animal that does not have bones
<b>mammal</b>	a type of animal that has hair or fur and usually does not lay eggs
<b>pattern</b>	something that happens again and again and again in a way that can be predicted
<b>reptile</b>	a type of animal that has scales and lays eggs
<b>vertebrate</b>	a type of animal that has bones
