<b>cornea</b>	the clear layer in front of the eye
<b>dissect</b>	to take something apart to study it
<b>experiment</b>	a test used to discover new information about a question
<b>function</b>	what something does
<b>iris</b>	the colored part of the eye that is shaped like a donut
<b>lens</b>	a clear object that changes the direction of light as it passes through
<b>light</b>	what comes from the Sun and lamps and makes it possible to see things
<b>model</b>	a pretend version of something that scientists use when the real thing is too big, small, or complicated to work with
<b>pupil</b>	the dark opening in the center of the eye
<b>retina</b>	the back of the eye that senses light and sends messages to the brain
<b>structure</b>	the specific form and shape of something
<b>vision</b>	the ability to see
