

## Lesson: How can you stop a landslide?

---

<b>canyon</b>	a deep hole in the ground formed over a long time by moving water
<b>cliff</b>	a high area of land with a side that is almost straight up-and-down
<b>design</b>	to make a plan for creating or doing something
<b>engineer</b>	a person who uses science to come up with solutions to problems
<b>erosion</b>	when tiny bits of rock are moved from one place to another
<b>hill</b>	a high area of land that isn't as tall as a mountain
<b>landslide</b>	when lots of rocks and soil roll down from a cliff or mountain
<b>model</b>	a pretend version of something that scientists use when the real thing is too big, small, or complicated to work with
<b>mountain</b>	a high area of land with steep sides
<b>protect</b>	to keep safe
<b>root</b>	a part of a plant that is usually under the ground
<b>soil</b>	tiny pieces of rock and other materials that cover the ground
<b>steep</b>	something that is very high up on one end and very low at the other end
<b>wildfire</b>	a big fire that spreads quickly
