

## Lesson: Can we make it rain?

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<b>atmosphere</b>	the air that surrounds a planet
<b>boil</b>	to heat a liquid until it bubbles and turns quickly into a gas
<b>condensation</b>	the process of a gas changing to a liquid
<b>cycle</b>	a set of events that repeats in the same order over and over
<b>evaporation</b>	the process of a liquid changing to a gas
<b>experiment</b>	a test used to discover new information about a question
<b>hydrosphere</b>	all the water (solid, liquid, gas) on and around planet Earth
<b>model</b>	a pretend version of something that scientists use when the real thing is too big, small, or complicated to work with
<b>observe</b>	to pay close attention to something
<b>precipitation</b>	water falling from clouds in the sky; including rain, snow, and hail
<b>predict</b>	to guess what will happen based on things you know
<b>temperature</b>	how hot or cold something is
<b>water cycle</b>	the movement of water between the ocean, air, and land
<b>water vapor</b>	water when it is a gas, such as steam
