

## Lesson: How can you keep a house from blowing away in a windstorm?

<b>construction engineer</b>	a person who designs, plans, and builds structures such as buildings
<b>design</b>	to make a plan for creating or doing something
<b>dust storm</b>	a type of windstorm that moves large amounts of dirt and sand
<b>engineer</b>	a person who uses science to come up with solutions to problems
<b>hurricane</b>	a type of windstorm that starts as a smaller storm over the ocean
<b>model</b>	a pretend version of something that scientists use when the real thing is too big, small, or complicated to work with
<b>natural hazard</b>	an event in nature (such as a landslide, earthquake, hurricane, or wildfire) that can be dangerous to living things
<b>storm</b>	weather that usually includes strong wind and rain or snow
<b>tornado</b>	a type of windstorm, shaped like a funnel, that happens with little warning
<b>windstorm</b>	a storm with very strong winds
