| <b>animal dispersal</b> | when an animal moves a seed from one place to another   |
| <b>compare</b>          | to notice what is similar and what is different between things  |
| <b>disperse</b>         | to move and spread out  |
| <b>model</b>            | a pretend version of something that scientists use when the real thing is too big, small, or complicated to work with |
| <b>observe</b>          | to pay close attention to something   |
| <b>seed</b>             | a part of a plant that can grow into a baby plant   |
| <b>seedling</b>         | a young plant that grows from a seed  |
| <b>structure</b>        | the specific form and shape of something  |
| <b>water dispersal</b>  | when water moves a seed from one place to another   |
| <b>wind dispersal</b>   | when the wind moves a seed from one place to another  |
