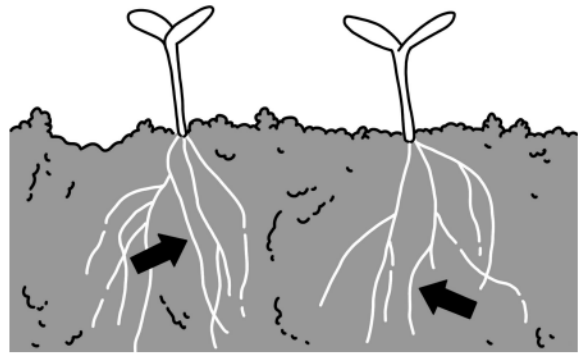

mystery science

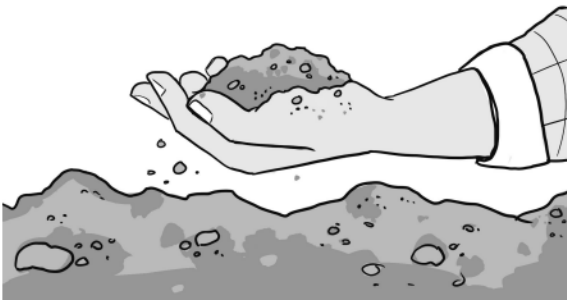
root



mystery science

a part of a plant that is usually under the ground

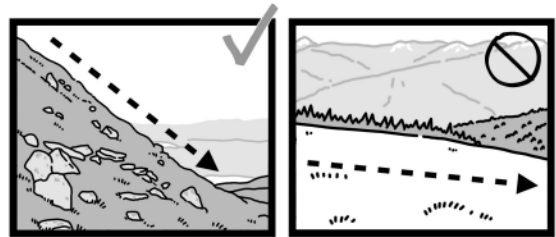
soil



mystery science

tiny pieces of rock and other materials that cover the ground

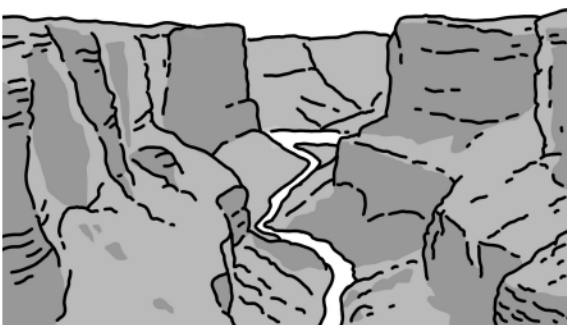
steep



mystery science

when something is very high up on one end and very low at the other end

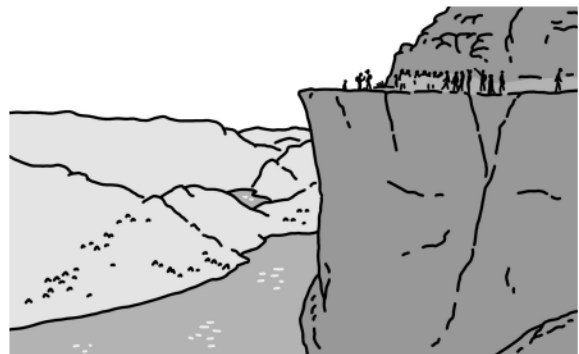
canyon



mystery science

a low area of land with sides that are almost straight up-and-down

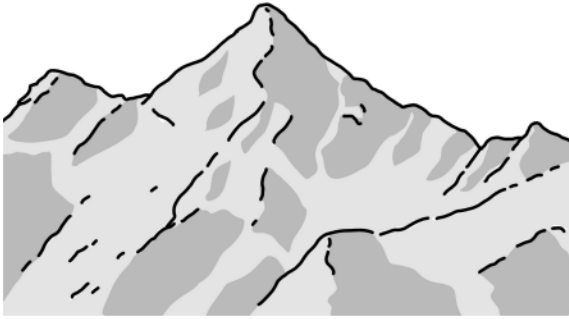
cliff



mystery science

a high area of land with a side that is almost straight up-and-down

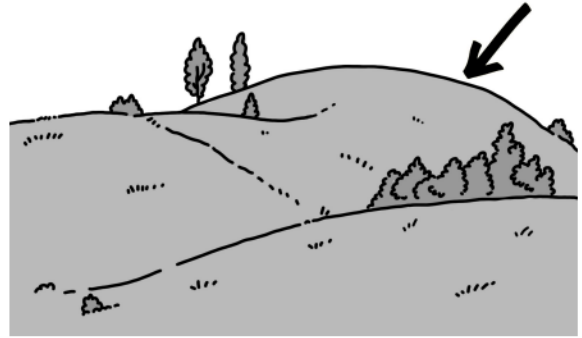
mountain



mystery science

a high area of land with steep sides

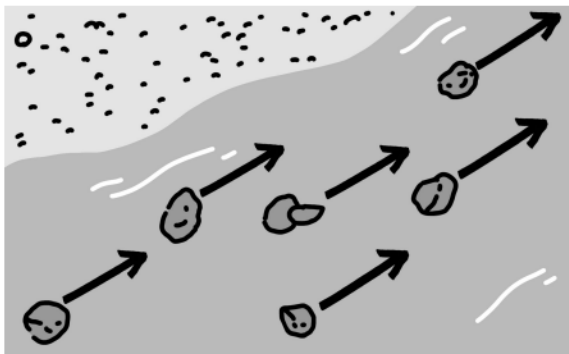
hill



mystery science

a high area of land that isn't as tall as a mountain

erosion



mystery science

when tiny bits of rock are moved from one place to another

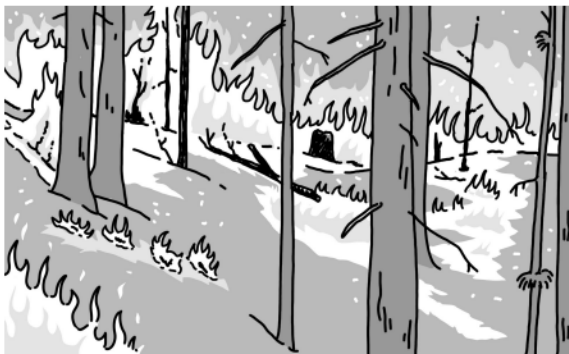
landslide



mystery science

when lots of rocks and soil roll down from a cliff or mountain

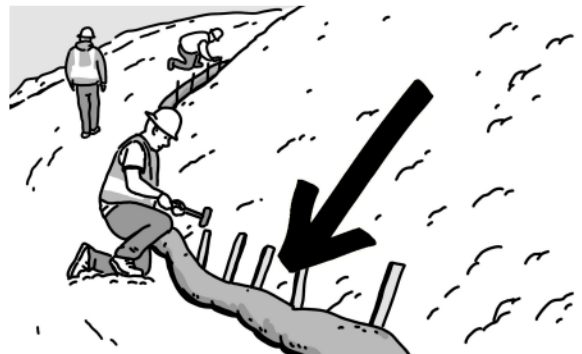
wildfire

a big fire that spreads quickly

to make a plan for creating or doing something

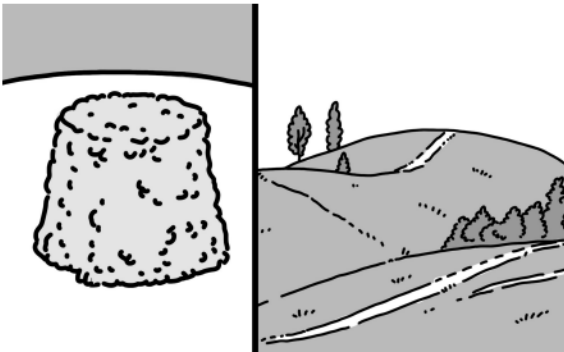
engineer
