

## Lesson: Why do frogs say “ribbit”?

---

<b>amphibian</b>	a type of animal that spends part of its life in water and part on land, such as frogs and toads
<b>communicate</b>	to give and get information
<b>compare</b>	to notice what is similar and what is different between things
<b>habitat</b>	the place where an animal or plant lives
<b>identify</b>	to figure out what or who something is
<b>lake</b>	a large area of water with land all around it
<b>pond</b>	an area of still water, larger than a puddle, but smaller than a lake
<b>rainforest</b>	a habitat that is usually warm and gets lots of rain
<b>species</b>	one specific kind of living thing
<b>swamp</b>	a habitat covered in water and filled with many trees
<b>vibrate</b>	to move back and forth quickly
