

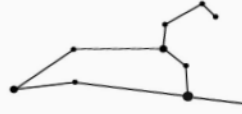

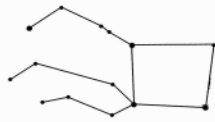

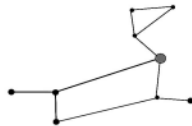

(head and front legs)

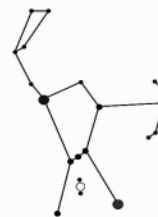


Cygnus, the flying Swan
