

Lesson: Where do animals find the water they need?

Arctic	area around the North Pole that is very cold
body of water	an area of water, such as a lake, pond, or ocean
freeze	when a liquid turns to solid, like when liquid water freezes to solid ice
ice	water when it is a frozen solid
lake	a large area of water with land all around it
liquid	a state of matter, such as water when you can pour it
matter	anything that takes up space; can be in different forms such as solid, liquid, or gas
melt	when a solid turns to liquid, like when solid ice melts to liquid water
observe	to pay close attention to something
ocean	a large area of salt water that covers the Earth
pond	an area of still water, larger than a puddle, but smaller than a lake
river	a long, thin area of water that flows
snow	solid water that falls from the sky when it's very cold outside
solid	a state of matter, such as water when it is frozen ice
states of matter	the different forms of matter that include solid, liquid, and gas
stream	a small river
waterfall	flowing water that falls from a tall place
