

## Lesson: Where's the best place to build a snow fort?

---

<b>Celsius</b>	one way to measure temperature; water freezes at 0 degrees Celsius
<b>data</b>	recorded measurements or observations
<b>degree</b>	a unit of measurement, such as for temperature
<b>Fahrenheit</b>	one way to measure temperature; water freezes at 32 degrees Fahrenheit
<b>freeze</b>	when a liquid turns into a solid, such as when water turns to ice
<b>freezing point</b>	the temperature when water starts to turn from liquid water into solid ice
<b>measure</b>	to describe something using numbers that can be compared
<b>pattern</b>	something that happens again and again and again in a way that can be predicted
<b>predict</b>	to guess what will happen based on things you know
<b>season</b>	a time of year with specific weather that repeats every year
<b>snow</b>	solid water that falls from the sky when it's very cold outside
<b>snowstorm</b>	a storm with lots of snow and usually strong winds
<b>storm</b>	weather that usually includes strong wind and rain or snow

## Lesson: Where's the best place to build a snow fort?

<b>summer</b>	one of the four seasons, the warmest season in some places
<b>temperature</b>	how hot or cold something is
<b>thermometer</b>	a tool that measures temperature
<b>weather</b>	what the air is like in a particular time and place, including things like temperature, wind, and rain
<b>winter</b>	one of the four seasons, the coldest season in some places
