erosion	when tiny bits of rock are moved from one location to another by water, wind, ice, or gravity
experiment	a test used to discover new information about a question
freeze	when a liquid turns to solid, like when liquid water freezes to solid ice
ice wedging	a process where water freezing and expanding causes rock to break apart
model	a pretend version of something that scientists use when the real thing is too big, small, or complicated to work with
mountain	a high area of land with very steep sides
root wedging	a process where a root growing causes rock to break apart
weathering	the process of breaking rocks into smaller pieces
