TRANSCRIPT

HOOK 1

Hi, it's Anne. Your Guidebooks look amazing and they're almost ready to share!

While we've been working on our writing, Shelly's eggs have been getting ready to hatch. It looks like today is a very special day! Let's watch.

Turtle experts like you will make a huge difference for turtles. Your writing can spread information to people everywhere so that everyone can help sea turtles be safe on the beach and safe at sea.

The final thing to do is decorate your Guidebook so it looks super fun and exciting on the cover.

After that, you'll take a look at your classmates' Guidebooks and leave some feedback for them.

I'll get you started, step by step.

STEP 1

Get your supplies.

STEP 2

Your teacher will tell you how much time you have to color the front and back of your Guidebook. You can finish later if you need more time.

STEP 3

Now that you've added some color to your Guidebook, you'll get a chance to share your writing and read some of your classmates' writing.

Get your supplies to get started.

STEP 4

Set up your desk so others can read your Guidebook. Put away everything except your Guidebook, sticky notes, and a pencil.

Hold the pencil in your hand.

STEP 5

Watch this whole step before you do anything.

When your teacher tells you it's time to go, quietly get up and choose another desk to sit at. Bring your pencil with you. Remember, it's important not to touch things that don't belong to you while you're at another desk.

STEP 6

Now you're at a different desk with a Guidebook written by someone else. Quietly read your classmates Guidebook.

STEP 7

Now that you've read someone else's writing, write them a note on one of the sticky notes to tell them something you liked about their writing. Here are some sentence ideas to help you get started.

Don't forget to write your name on the sticky note and stick it on the desk when you're done.

STEP 8

Quietly walk to a new desk and follow the same steps again.

If you have time, you can read a third. Your teacher will tell you when it's time to return to your own desk.

WRAP UP

You are now accomplished writers with a published piece of work! You can look at all the notes your classmates left you to see which parts they liked best.
