Why are there so many

Pollinate:

Watermelon flowers
Cantaloupe flowers

Andrena Bees



Pollinate:

Strawberry flowers
Cucumber flowers

The rules are exactly the same, so you can refer to the Game Rules sheet.

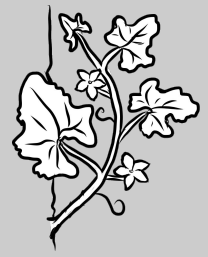
