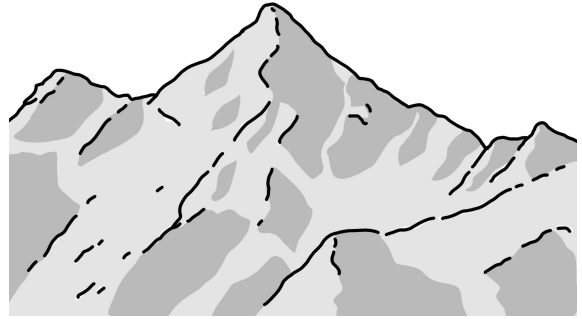

mystery science

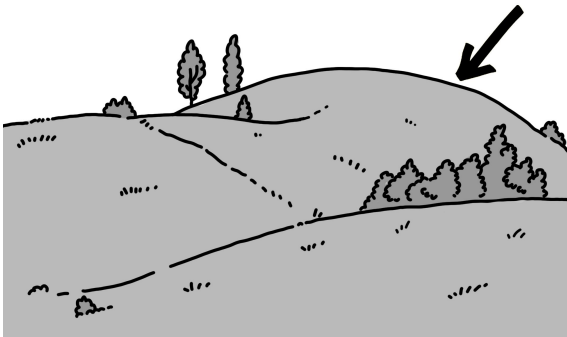
mountain

a high area of land with steep sides

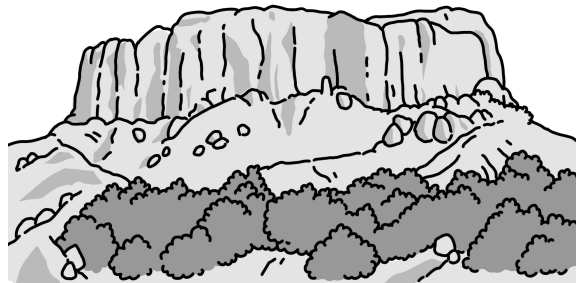
hill

a high area of land that isn't as tall as a mountain

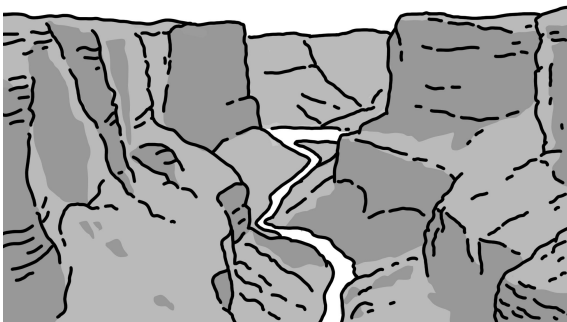
mesa

a high area of land with a flat top and sides that are almost straight up-and-down

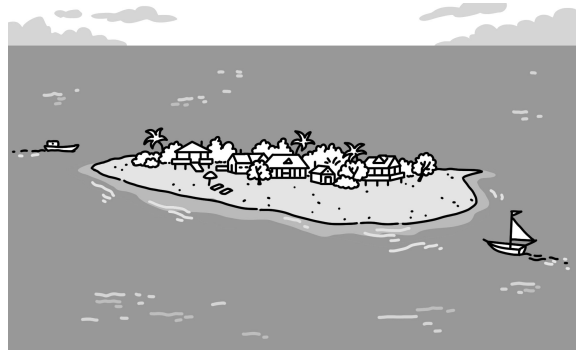
canyon

a low area of land with sides that are almost straight up-and-down

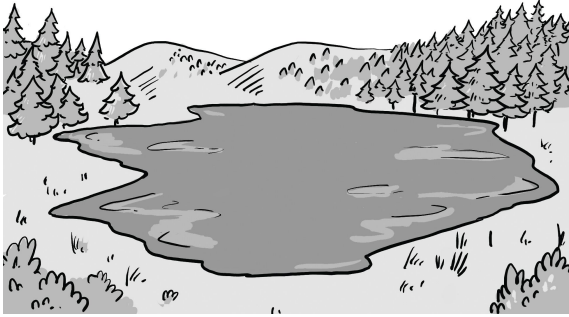
island

land with water all around it

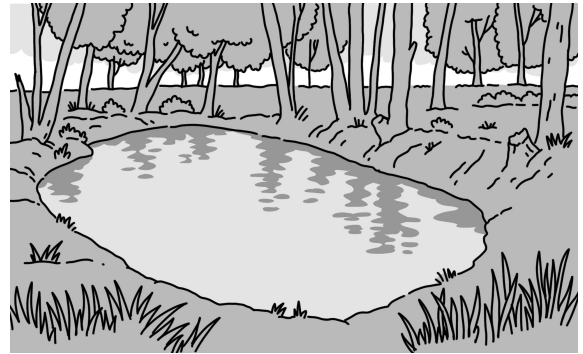
lake

a large area of water with land all around it

an area of still water, larger than a puddle, but smaller than a lake

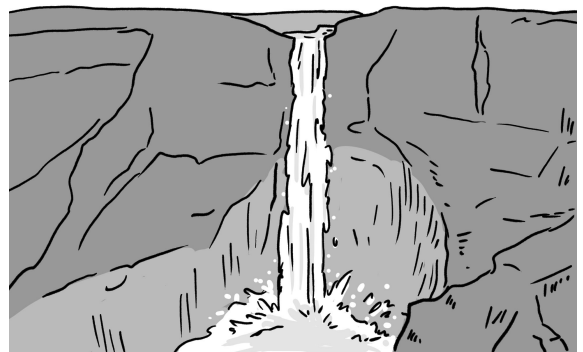
river

a long, thin area of water that flows

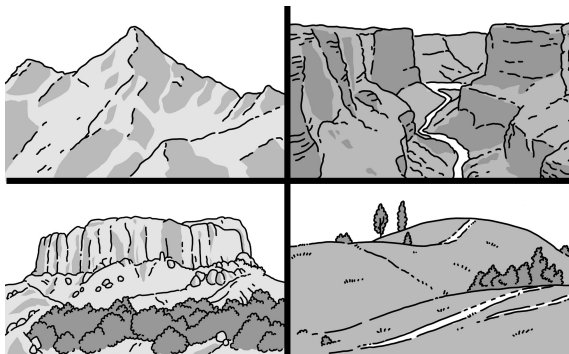
waterfall

flowing water that falls from a tall place

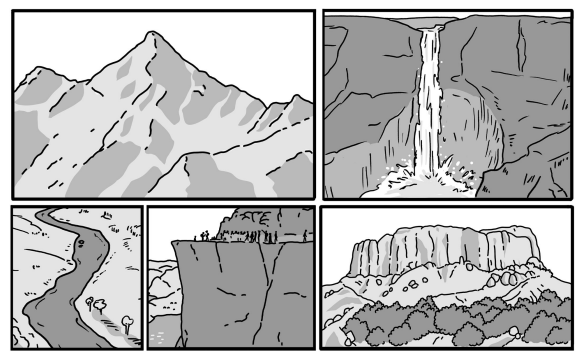
landform

a natural structure of Earth's surface, like a mountain or canyon

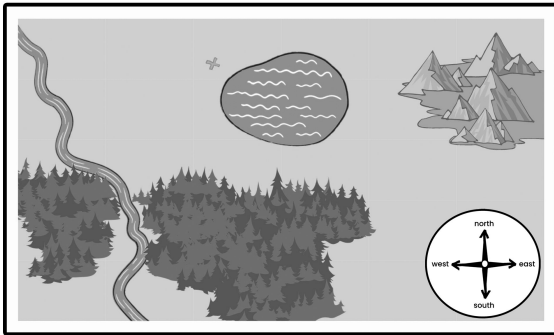
feature

an important part of a place or thing

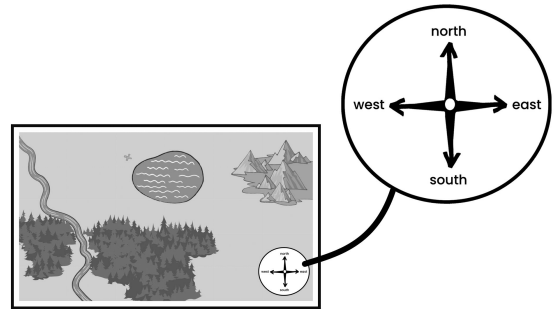
map

a picture that shows the features of a place and where those features are

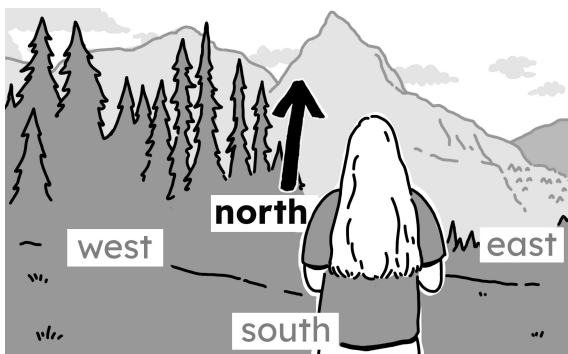
compass star (compass rose)

a drawing on a map that points to the four main directions (north, south, east, west)

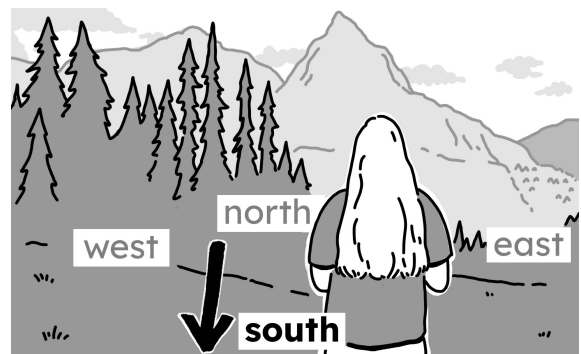
north

one of four main directions; when you face north, west is to the left and east is to the right

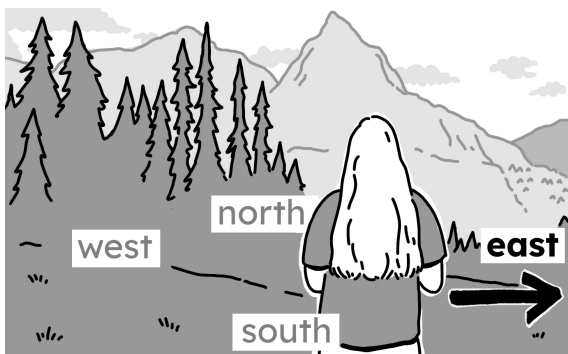
south

one of four main directions; if you are facing north, it is the direction behind you

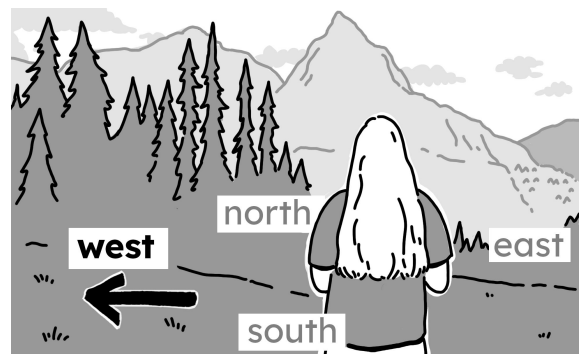
east
