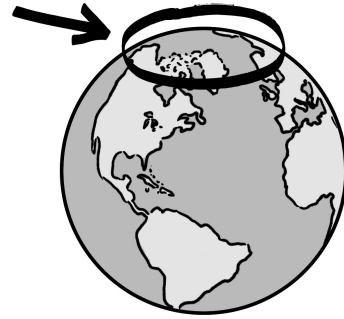

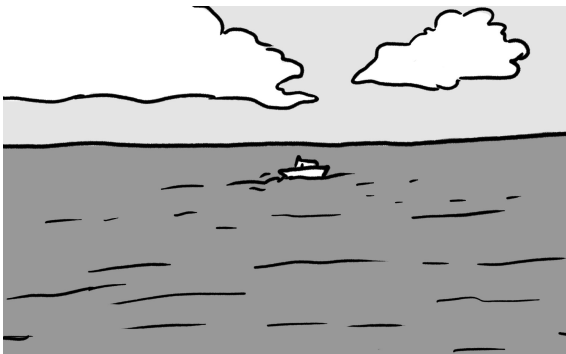
Arctic

area around the North Pole that is very cold

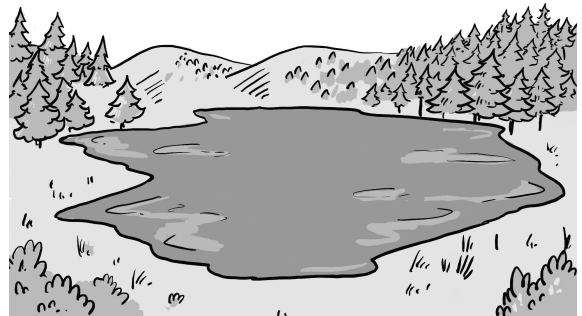
ocean

mystery science

a large area of water with land all around it

pond



mystery science

an area of still water, larger than a puddle, but smaller than a lake

river

a long, thin area of water that flows

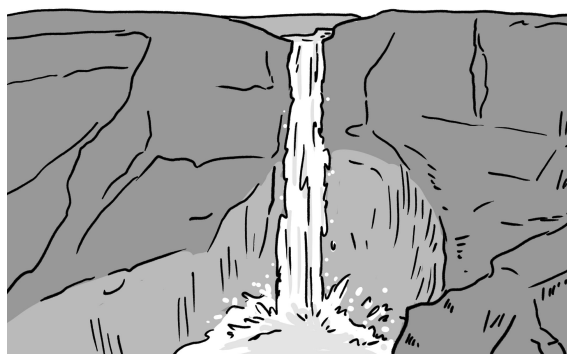
stream

a small river

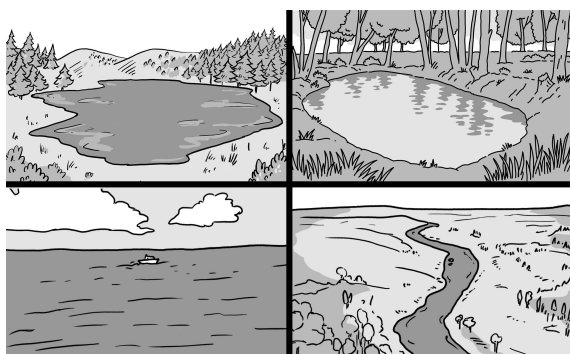
waterfall

flowing water that falls from a tall place

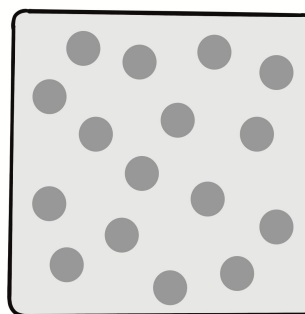
body of water



mystery science

an area of water, such as a lake, pond, or ocean

matter



mystery science

anything that takes up space and has weight; can be in different forms such as solid, liquid, or gas

states of matter



mystery science

the different forms of matter that include solid, liquid, and gas

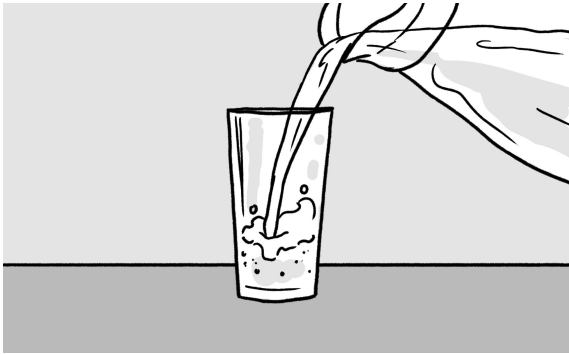
solid



mystery science

a state of matter, such as water when it is frozen ice

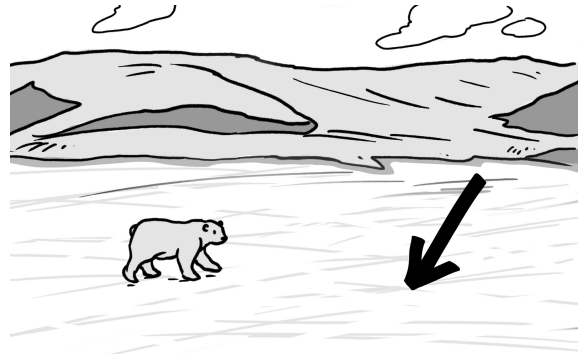
liquid



mystery science

a state of matter, such as water when you can pour it

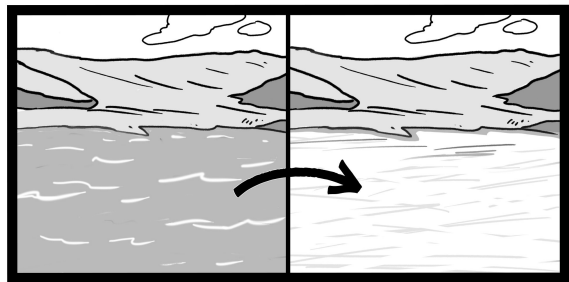
ice



mystery science

water when it is a frozen solid

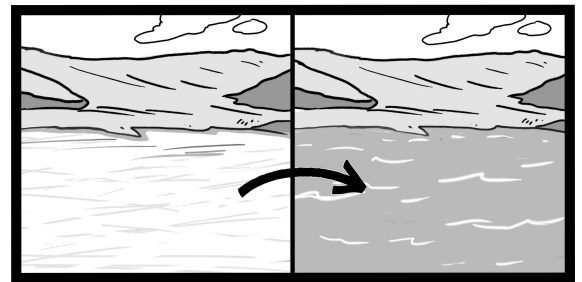
freeze

when a liquid turns to solid, like when liquid water becomes solid ice

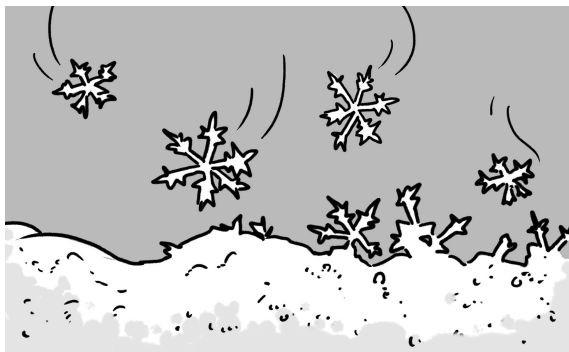
melt

when a solid turns to liquid, like when solid ice becomes liquid water
