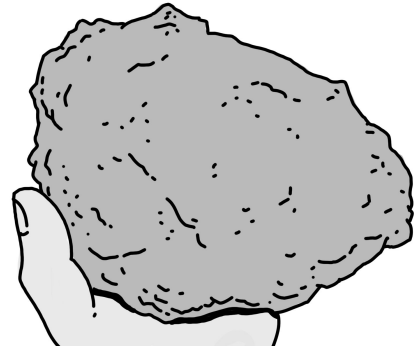

mystery science

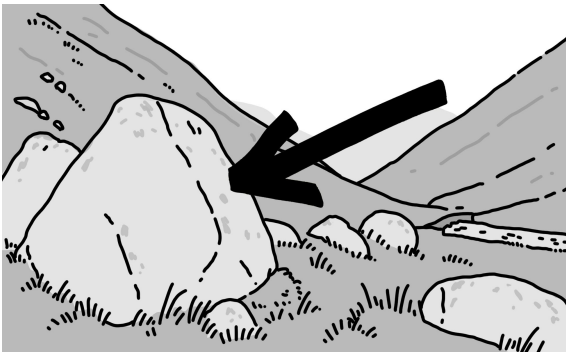
rock



mystery science

a solid natural material that is found on and under the surface of the Earth

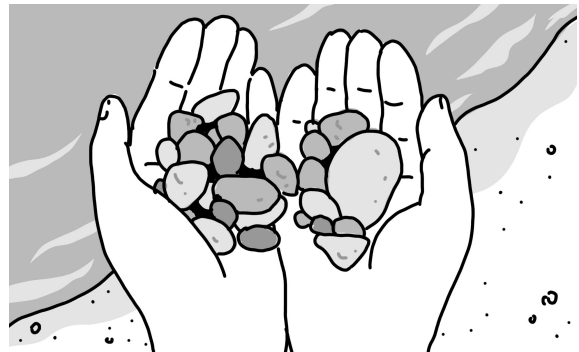
boulder



mystery science

a large rock

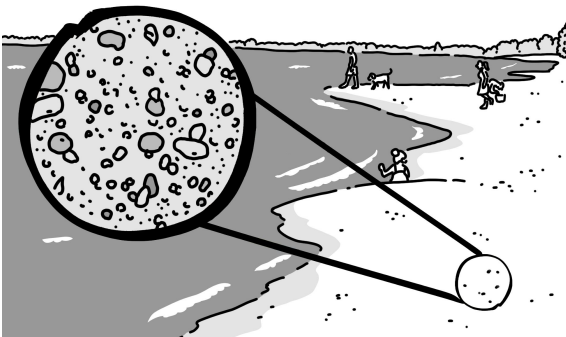
pebble



mystery science

a small rock, usually with smooth edges

sand



mystery science

very tiny pieces of rock, such as what you often see on the ground at a beach

beach



mystery science

land next to a large area of water, often covered in sand

flow



mystery science

to move along

river



mystery science

a long, thin area of water that flows

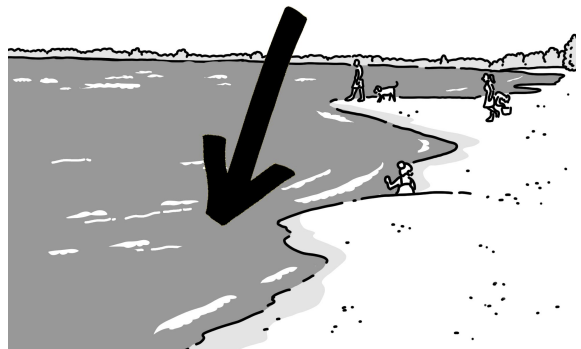
downstream

toward the direction that water in a river or stream flows

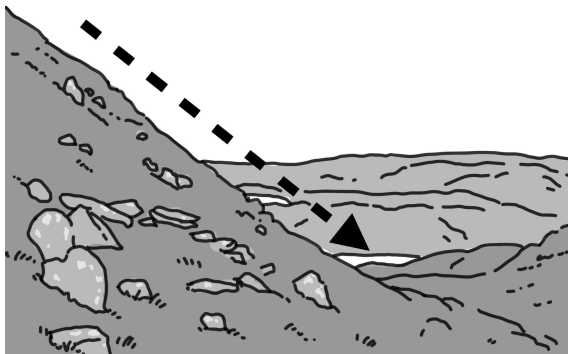
ocean

a large area of salt water that covers the Earth

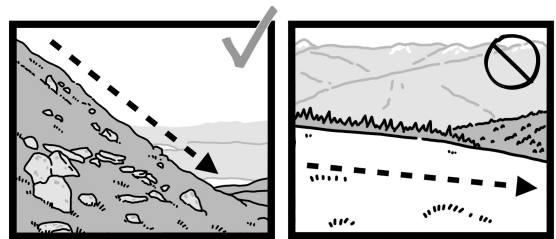
slope

where one side is higher than the other

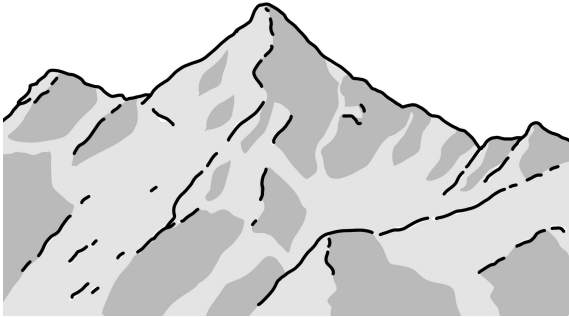
steep

when something is very high up on one end and very low at the other end

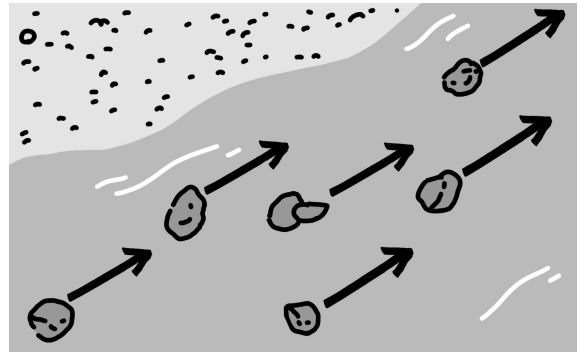
mountain



a high area of land with steep sides

erosion



when tiny bits of rock are moved from one place to another

mystery science

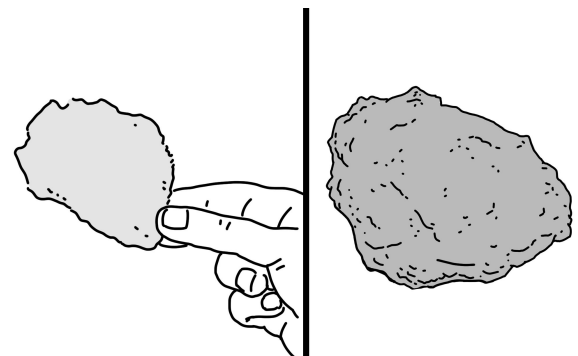
microscope
