<b>behavior</b>	the actions and reactions of living things
<b>communicate</b>	to exchange information
<b>environment</b>	a living thing's surroundings, including other living things and non-living parts like soil, water, and air
<b>evidence</b>	information that can be used to support or reject an idea
<b>observe</b>	to pay close attention to something
<b>predator</b>	an animal that hunts and eats other animals
<b>protection</b>	the act of keeping something or someone safe
<b>social behavior</b>	behaviors of living things that live in groups
<b>survive</b>	to stay alive
