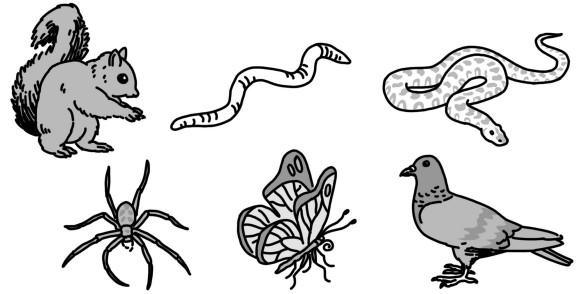

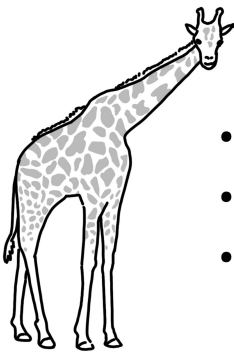
animal

characteristic

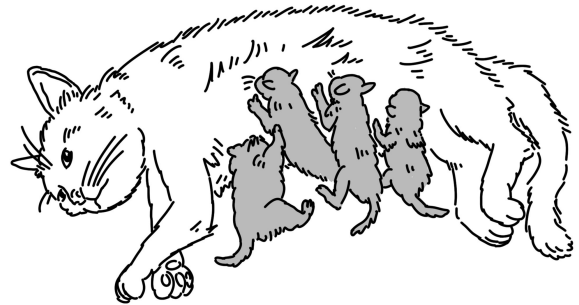


- furry

something you can observe about an object, place, or living thing

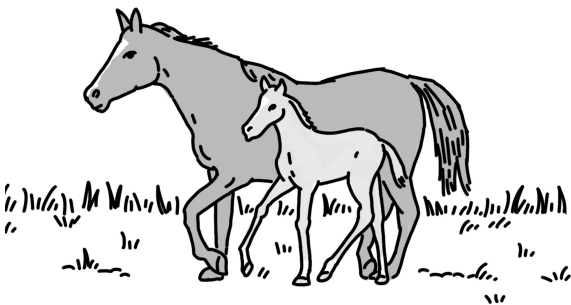
birth

when animals have babies

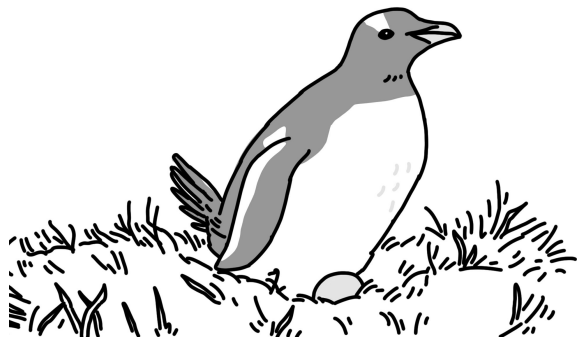
mammal

a type of animal that has hair or fur and usually does not lay eggs

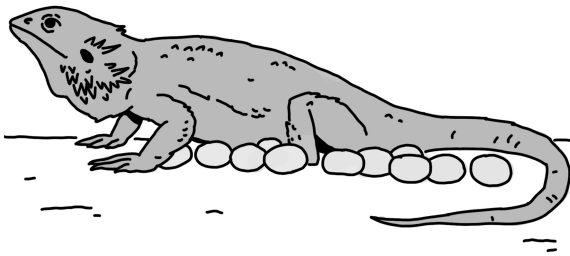
bird

a type of animal that has feathers and lays eggs

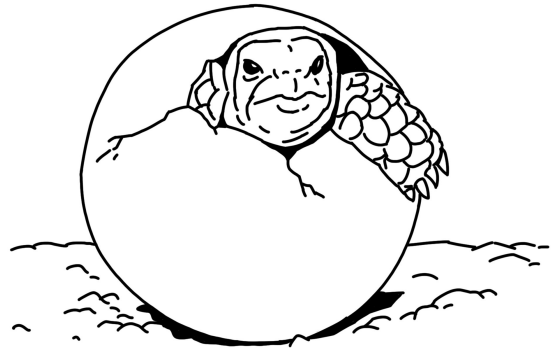
reptile

a type of animal that has scales and lays eggs

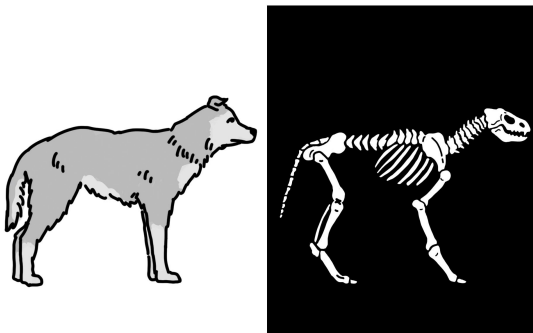
hatch

to come out of an egg

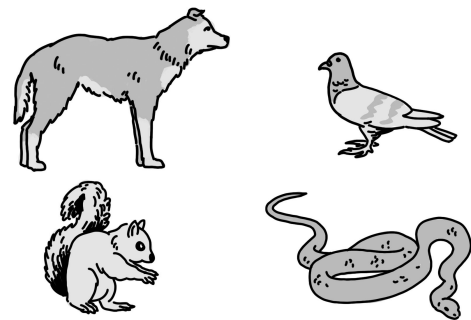
bones

the hard parts inside many animals that help give their bodies shape

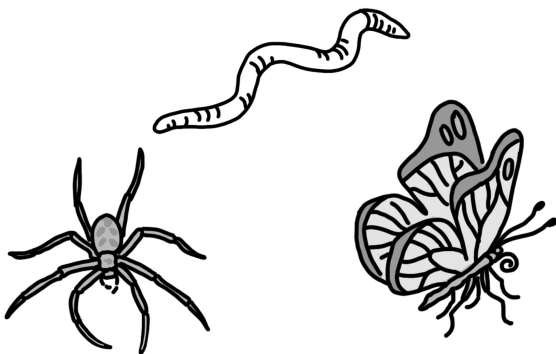
vertebrate

a type of animal that has bones

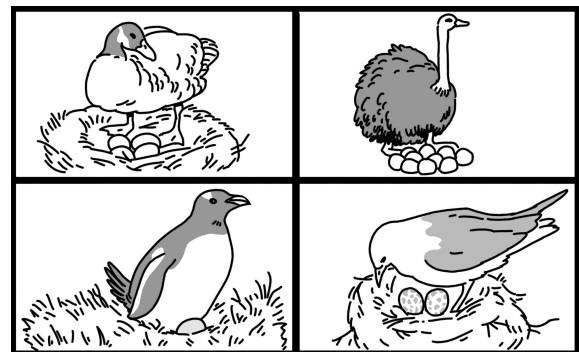
invertebrate
