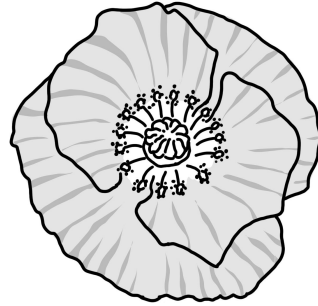

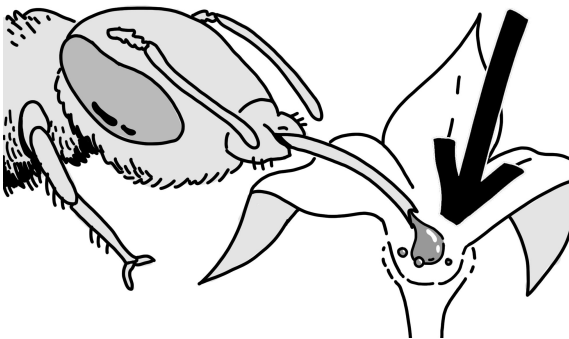
flower

a part of a plant that is usually brightly colored

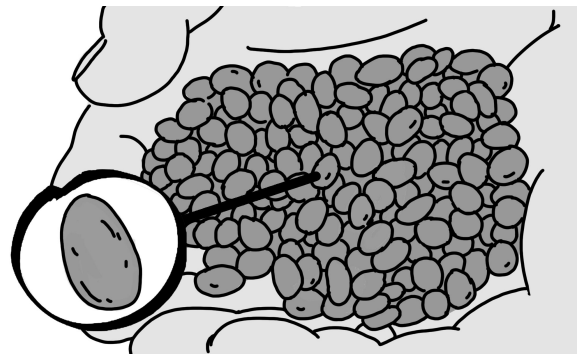
nectar

a sugary liquid that plants make

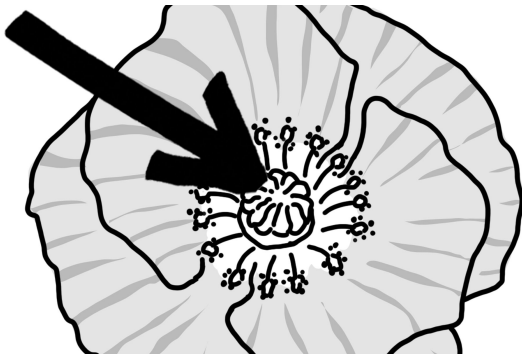
seed

a part of a flower that is sticky and helps the plant make seeds

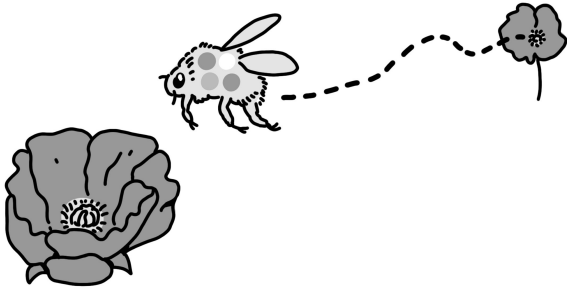
pollen

a part of a flower that is powdery and helps the plant make seeds

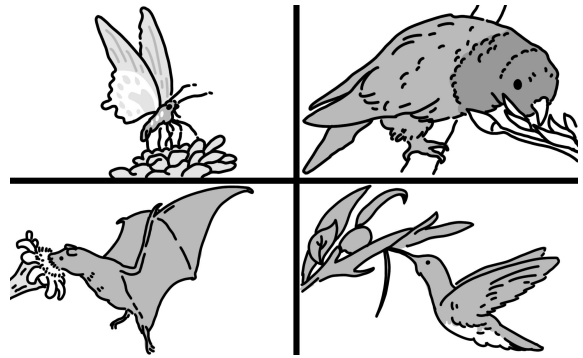
pollination

a living thing that moves pollen from one flower to the stigma of another flower

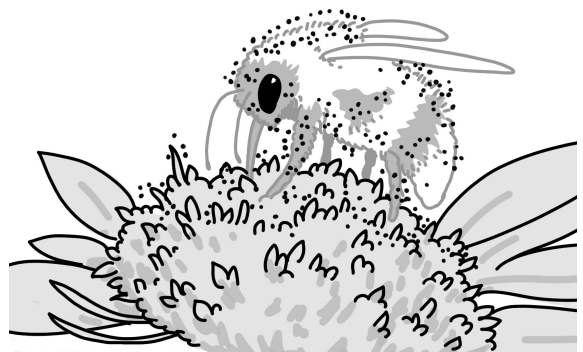
structure

the specific form and shape of something

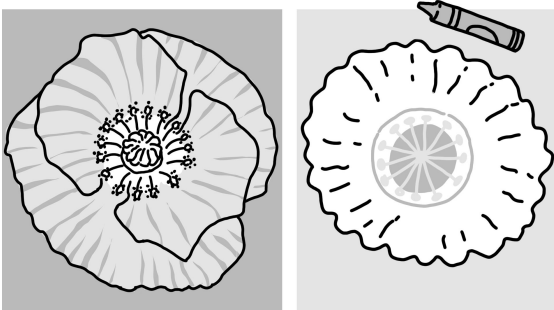
